

ADMISSION PROCESS AND CRITERIA.

Admissions open to all classes from Nursery to IX and XI (Sci and Com) in **CBSE and Gujarat Board**. Applying for registration does not imply admission, which is subject to observation - cum - interaction / written test. It is also subject to the availability of seats.

- The registration form duly filled in all respects should be presented to the school along with the required documents and registration fee, before the last date as mentioned in the admission schedule. Applications presented after the expiry of the due date or incomplete application form with incomplete documents will not be accepted.
- The registration form is not transferable and only the form issued by the school should be used for registration of the child. Parents are requested to go through the Prospectus and information carefully before filling the registration form. It is advised that the parents should fill the Registration Form themselves only.

Documents required for Registration

- The following documents along with the completely filled application form are to be presented before the expiry of due date :
- The Registration Form
- Previous School's Transfer Certificate
- Previous year's Progress Report (photocopy)
- Indemnity Document
- NOC from previous School
- Attested Photocopy of the Birth Certificate
- Medical Report of a Child
- Family Photo - 1 (Post card size)
- Applicant's stamp size Photo - 1
- Attested Photocopy of Adhaar card

Originals of the above documents will be required for verification at the time of admission. The registration form will be rejected if any discrepancy is found between the particulars filled in the form and the supporting documents.

Pre-Primary and Primary admission will be granted on the basis of Observation cum Interaction. Presence of both the Parents during the time of admission is mandatory.

Classes II - IX and XI Written test and Interaction

For classes II onwards, a formal written test will be conducted in English, Maths and General awareness to check the linguistic proficiency, mathematical ability and general knowledge for assessing the suitability for admission to the next class. Students should come 30 minutes before the start of the test. They should bring their own pencil/pen, colour pencil, geometry box.

The parents of the successful candidates will be informed for the completion of admission formalities

Admission: No candidate will be admitted to school without clearing the Observation -cum-Interaction/written test.

Fee: All payments should be made through A/c payee cheque in favour of Lancers Army School.

Age Criteria: Nursery - 2years 6 Month

Age of the candidate as on 31st March as recorded in the birth certificate, will determine the eligibility for admission to a particular class.
